**PUBLIC HEARINGS NOTICE**

**MEDICAID INNOVATION AND REFORM COMMISSION**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE MEDICAID INNOVATION AND REFORM COMMISSION (MIRC) WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE DELIBERATIONS OF THE MIRC ON TUESDAY, OCTOBER 15, 2013 IN HOUSE ROOM D OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY BUILDING, 201 NORTH 9<sup>TH</sup> STREET, RICHMOND, VIRGINIA. THE HEARING WILL BEGIN AT 1:00 P.M.

The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments on reforms being considered by the Medicaid Innovation and Reform Commission as the Commission determines whether or not to expand Medicaid for newly eligible individuals pursuant to the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act.

Those persons wishing to speak may register at the hearing site **no earlier than two hours prior** to the start of the hearing. Speakers are asked to follow these guidelines:

- Speakers will be taken in the order of registration.
- Each person may register only one speaker at a time.
- Speakers are asked to limit their comments to three minutes or less.
- Speakers representing groups and organizations should consolidate remarks to avoid duplication.
