Comment - Because my 44y.o. son, who has a chronic mental illness, makes about \$150 too much with his SSDI, he is not able to participate in treatment programs(group homes; daily assistance with meds, meals, etc.; and more wrap around services) that would keep him safe, increase his quality of life, and substantially lower hospitalizations and frequency of episodes. Expanding Medicaid would greatly assist in his receiving better services. After child support and medicare payments are deducted, he has less than \$800/mo. to live on which will not cover any additional medical or supportive services that could help him be safe and more stable.
