Dear Medicaid Innovation and Reform Commission,

Please expand Medicaid to Virginians who "are too poor" to qualify for a subsidy under the ACA, but who don't currently qualify for Medicaid!

A typical family of 4 who makes \$23,500 will not get any subsidy under ACA and would potentially face a \$10,000 medical coverage plan (cost prohibitive), while a similar family making just \$500 more: \$24,000, would only have to pay about \$500 for the same plan! Even more outrageous that a family making as much as \$94,000 per year would get about a \$1,000 subsidy, while the \$23,500 family gets NOTHING. PLEASE fix this.
