**Comment** - Medicaid has proven to provide worse healthcare outcomes than private insurance, and in some cases, worse than no insurance at all. Therefore, exapnding the program would be immoral. Besides, the federal government is already \$17 trillion in debt, and Medicaid expansion would increase this debt, leaving our children and grandchildren to pay for it. Also, Medicaid expansion is a significant part of the Obama Administration's attempt to transform our healthcare system into a single-payer, government run program.
